*Call to Worship (Responsive):

One: Let us offer praise to our one God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

All: Help us to worship you, one God in three Persons, by proclaiming and living our faith in you. (Symbols are brought forward to the altar during the following.)

One: We honour God as Father and Creator of all that is, all that is seen and unseen. All things come into being as an outpouring of the abundant love that the Father shares with the Son and the Spirit. Creation is a gift from the love of the Father.

All: Glory to the Father!

One: We honour God as Son who is the Word of God made flesh. Christ is more than words on pages; rather, Christ is the living Word of God spoken eternally from the heart of God and through all the ages. The Bible is a gift inspired by the Son who is the living Word of God.

All: Glory to the Son!

One: We honour God as Holy Spirit who lives in the Church and builds us up into the body of Christ. A church of brick and mortar is only a sign of the true Church made of living stones. We are those living stones that become the Church – the body of Christ – by the power of the Holy Spirit. The living Church is a sign of the presence of the Holy Spirit who is working to transform all of creation into the image of God.
